MA:	inhibition of type 1 angiotensin II receptor	Effects
EF:	selective blockage of angiotensin II-effects without action on bradykinin breakdown	Adverse effects
AE:	headache, dizziness, nausea, abdominal pain	Contraindications
CI:	renal artery stenosis following renal transplantation, primary hyperaldosteronism, biliary cirrhosis, severe hepatic damage	Active agent (INN)
Candesartan	PRC C(1st), D(2nd, 3rd trim.), Lact ?	Elimination half-life, pregnancy risk category, lactation rating (n/a = not available)
